Russian sociologist L.E. Green defines the term globalization as follows: “Globalization is the result of the integration and rapprochement of regions and the world as a whole. Globalization is a process that makes the world more connected and interdependent to all its subjects. ”

K. Kamilov describes the following types of globalization. The process of globalization is divided into different groups in research. For example, economic globalization, political globalization, social globalization, ideological

globalization. Research has also focused on this aspect. But globalization is also having a profound effect on spirituality. In this process, it is possible to emphasize the events that are taking place, especially in the religious sphere. Today, religious globalization is also used as an independent phenomenon.
