The Samarkand summit further strengthened our confidence in the future of our homeland. It determined the international reputation of our Uzbekistan. It once again demonstrated that our reforms are recognized worldwide. Within the framework of the summit,

agreements were reached to expand close cooperation with the European Union on security. It includes border protection, effective information exchange, exchange of experience in the field of cyber defense, and the fight against human trafficking. Also, the current state and prospects of mutual cooperation and partnership relations between the peoples of Europe and Central Asia, that is, the two regions, were summarized, unused opportunities and gaps were identified, and strategies for turning them into real potential were outlined, the spirit of mutual trust was strengthened, and the political and legal foundations of long-term interregional strategic partnership were created. Central Asian countries and European Union institutions agreed to raise mutual cooperation to the level of strategic partnership and signed the Joint Declaration, which envisages the establishment of strategic partnership between the two regions. Within the framework of the summit, several joint projects were signed, among which the construction sector took a special place.
